THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 3rd January, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 5th January, 1956, under Notification No. 8 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Pano Platres (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 642, 1284 and 709 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 12th July, 1956, 28th December, 1956 and 18th July, 1957, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 2nd January, 1958;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 3rd January, 1958, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

No. 1115. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Notification No. 107 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th February, 1956, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All those areas of privately-owned lands, with everything standing thereon, situated at Mosphiloti village, comprising 1 evlek or thereabouts, forming parts of plots Nos. 15 and 20 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXIX.40, more particularly defined as the areas coloured red on the plan signed by the Director of Public Works and dated the 4th December, 1957.

Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands, who objects to the acquisition, is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Government is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said land.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.
