THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. Laws 17 and 47 of 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 10) Order, 1957.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the Schedule hereto shall be out of doors as from 17.30 hours to 05.00 hours daily until further notice, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any person who is not a Turkish Cypriot male born on or before 31st December, 1929, or after 1st January, 1945.

This Order is in addition to and not in derogation of the Order dated 5th day of November, 1956, published as Notification No. 1061 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 8th November, 1956, as amended by Notification No. 19 dated 24th December, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 3rd January, 1957.

This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of February, 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Famagusta District No. 1) Order, 1957.
- 2. No Greek Cypriot or Turkish Cypriot born on or after the 1st January, 1930, shall be out of doors within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the *Commissioner of Famagusta or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 3rd day of February, 1957.

FIRST SCHEDULE. Within the Municipal area of Famagusta.

SECOND SCHEDULE. From 05.00 hours on 3rd February, 1957 until 05.00 hours on 4th February, 1957.
