THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 17) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas by Order dated 10th July, 1956, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956, under Notification No. 686, I authorized the use by the Security Forces of the properties set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Kato Polemidhia village, subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas I am satisfied that the lands should continue to be used by the Security Forces for a further period of six months as from the expiration of the Order:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 17) 1956, and delegated to me under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, Robert Chattan Ross-Clunis, Commissioner of Limassol, do order that the aforesaid authorization for using the property by the Security Forces subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the expiration of the Order, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 17) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 63A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 63A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 17) 1956, I, Robert Chattan Ross-Clunis, the Commissioner of the District of Limassol, do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Control of Sound Signals) (Limassol District) Order, 1957.

2. The sounding of sirens, hooters or any form of sound signal within the area of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol is hereby prohibited.

3. An "alarm signal" and an "all clear" signal shall be in force in the area of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol and it is hereby directed that the following steps shall be taken by the members of the public upon the sounding of the "alarm signal" and until the sounding of the "all-clear signal":—

- (a) all vehicles shall be drawn to the side of the road and remain stationary until the sounding of the "all-clear signal"; and
- (b) all pedestrians shall stand clear of the streets and pavements as far as is reasonably possible for them to do so and shall not walk about until the sounding of the "all-clear signal".
