THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 19th July, 1956, I, Warren Frederick Martin Clemens, do hereby order as follows :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 32) (Amendment) Order, 1956.

2. The proviso to paragraph 2 of the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 32) Order, 1956, published as Notification No. 1061 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 8th November, 1956, is hereby deleted and substituted as follows :-

"Provided that this Order shall not apply to any person who is not a male Greek Cypriot born on or after the 1st January, 1930."
