THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.
LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Troodos Sub-Area No. 12 Order, 1957.

2. No person within the area specified in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit by the Assistant Commissioner in the Troodos Sub-Area or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any Member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 18th day of February, 1957.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

All areas bounded on the north from a line drawn from Karvounas through Kyperounda to Khandria, on the east by a line drawn from Khandria to Agros, on the south by a line drawn from Agros through Dhymes to Kato Amiandos and on the west by a line drawn from Kato Amiandos to Karvounas.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 12.00 hours until further notice.
