THE DETENTION OF PERSONS LAWS, 1955.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2923

MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the proviso to section 5 of the Detention of Persons Laws, 1955, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Detention of Persons (Continuance) Order, 1957.

2. The Detention of Persons Laws, 1955, shall continue in operation for a period of six months from the 1st day of May, 1957, that is until the 31st day of October, 1957, and shall then expire unless continued in force for any further period or periods of six months by the Governor-in-Council, by Order published in the *Gazette*, under the provisions of the proviso to section 5 of the said Laws.
