

No. 388. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to His Excellency the Governor that it is desirable in the public interest to improve and extend the Acropolis Secondary School at Strovolos :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, His Excellency the Governor does hereby declare the improvement and extension to the said school and the acquisition of land in connection therewith to be an undertaking of public utility, and does hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking under the provisions of the said Law, and does hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Education.
