No. 402. THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY (TENURE, REGISTRATION AND VALUATION) LAW.

CAP. 231 AND LAWS 8 OF 1953 AND 4 OF 1954.

Notice under Section 18 (c).

Whereas the communal property under plot No. 5/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXVIII.37 comprising 3 evleks and 2,000 square feet or thereabouts, is required for the establishment of an additional burial ground for use by the Greek-Orthodox Community of Linou village, Nicosia District, an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Village Commission of Linou, on behalf of the village community, have requested that the aforesaid communal property should cease to be communal property and be registered as an additional burial ground for the Greek-Othodox Community of the said village, and have declared that they do not claim the assignment, in lieu of such communal property, of Crown property of equal utility as the said communal property or the payment of a sum equal to the value of the said communal property to be disposed for the benefit of the said village:
