

(3) The provisions of section 5 of the Law with respect to the first meeting of proprietors shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to a meeting convened under the provisions of this regulation.

(4) Any money in the hands of the Board or the Treasurer at the time of the dissolution of the Division and any money recovered at any time thereafter on account of the rates due and unpaid at the time of such dissolution, shall, following the discharge of any debts or liabilities of the Board, be paid to the Commissioner who shall utilize them for such purpose of public utility in the village of Galinoporni as may be approved by him.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to explain its general purport).
