NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 38A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 38A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, do hereby entirely suspend, as from the date hereof and until further notice, the operation of paragraph (3) of the said Regulation in respect of the area declared to be a Danger Area under the Danger Areas (Famagusta District No. 1) Order, 1956.

THE DEFENCE (IMPORTATION OF GOODS) REGULATIONS, 1956.

NOTICE (No. 12) UNDER CLAUSE 3 OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

The import into the Colony by any importer registered under the provisions of the Defence (Registration of Importers) Order, 1956, of the goods shown in the List hereunder from Japan is hereby permitted without a written licence under regulation 3 (1) (a) of the above named Regulations, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) that payment for such goods shall be made in sterling to a Transferable Account;
- (b) that such goods shall originate in and imported from Japan;
- (c) that shipment of such goods will be made not later than the 15th September, 1957, and the goods shall be cleared from Customs on or before the 15th December, 1957.
