CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it was represented to His Excellency the Governor that it was - desirable in the public interest to erect a secondary school at Ktima (Paphos)

in the District of Paphos:

Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, His Excellency the Governor has declared the erection of the said school and any other erections or structures as are from time to time considered to be necessary in connection with the school and the provision of access roads thereto to be an undertaking of public utility, and has authorized the carrying out of the said undertaking, under the provisions of the said Law, and has further entrusted the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Education.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to me to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorize its use in the interest of public order and safety:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, which I have been authorized to exercise under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 26th November, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, hereby take possession of the land and in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, I hereby direct and order as follows:—

(1) The use of the land for the requirements of Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorized.

(2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorized to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.

(3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

All the privately owned land situated at Pyroi and Potamia villages, Nicosia District, that is to say :-

The land under part of plot Nos. 180, 186 and the wayleave for a water pipeline on part of plot Nos. 3, 4, 20, 22, 23, 169, 170, 171, 172, 164, 175, 185/1, 185/2, 188, 189/1, 190, 236, 57 and 60 of the Government Survey Plans XXXI.34, XXXI.35 and XXXI.42, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings on the 13th May, 1957, copy of which is deposited in the Office of the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia.

THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia/Kyrenia District No. L.20) Order, 1957.
- 2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Assistant Commissioner of Lefka or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 19th day of March, 1957.

From 17.00 hours on the 19th March, 1957, until further notice.
