Notification under Sections 2, 3 and 5.

Whereas it has been represented to His Excellency the Governor that it is desirable for air force purposes to establish an outfall sewer and sewage works at Pergamos in the District of Larnaca, together with such ancillary buildings, erections, structures and other installations as may be necessary to operate and maintain such sewer and sewage works, the cost whereof is to be borne by Her Majesty's Air Force Authorities (hereinafter referred to as "the sewer and sewage works"):

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, has been pleased to declare the establishment of the sewer and sewage works to be an undertaking of public utility and has been pleased to authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking under the provisions of the said Law and has further been pleased to entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to Wing Commander Ernest Alfred Turner, the Superintending Engineer, Air Ministry Directorate-General of Works, Headquarters Works Area, Cyprus, or in his absence to the person acting for the time being as Superintending Engineer, Air Ministry Directorate-General of Works, Headquarters Works Area, Cyprus.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notification No. 124 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 23rd February, 1956, the Governor declared the widening, improving and realigning of the public road between Famagusta and Larnaca to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Commissioner of Famagusta in compliance with section 6 of the Land Acquisition Law, by notices published under Notifications (Nos. 338 and 339) in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 28th March, 1957, gave particulars of portions of the lands required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking (hereinafter referred to as "the lands");

And whereas the Commissioner of Famagusta forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plans and particulars, no objections having been made;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plans and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the lands be acquired:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the lands under the provisions of the said Law.
