NOTICE UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notification published under No. 494 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 2nd May, 1957, the Governor declared under sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law the erection of a Rural Health Centre at Panayia, Paphos District, to be an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Paphos by a notice published under Notification No. 503 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 2nd May, 1957, gave particulars of the lands (hereinafter referred to as "the lands") required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Paphos forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plans and particulars, together with a report that no objections have been made ;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the lands be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the lands under the provisions of the said Law.

No. 558. THE BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS LAW.  
CAP. 222 AND LAW 23 OF 1951.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 2.

Whereas in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, as contained in the Bombardment Range Areas (Amendment) Law, 1951, His Excellency the Governor declared the areas set out in the Schedules to this Notice to be Bombardment Range Areas ;

And whereas the periods of validity of the declarations aforesaid were from time to time extended :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 aforesaid His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that—

- (1) the areas set out in the First Schedule to this Notice shall be Bombardment Range Areas for use by Her Majesty's Forces, for a period of 12 calendar months from the date of this Notice as practice areas for the use of all kinds of ammunition (including rocket projectiles) from any vessel, aircraft, vehicle, artillery weapon, firearm or any other weapon issued for use by Her Majesty's Forces, or for the dropping of live or other bombs from any aircraft or for detonations ;
- (2) the areas set out in the Second Schedule to this Notice shall be Bombardment Range Areas for use by Her Majesty's Forces, for a period of 12 calendar months from the date of this Notice as practice areas for the use of all kinds of small arms and the ammunition therefor ;
- (3) the declaration of the Dhekelia Bombardment Range Area by Notification No. 200 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th April, 1953, and the declaration of the Pyla Bombardment Range Area and the Larnaca Bombardment Range Area by Notification No. 803 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette*
