In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to (No. 2) 1956, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Special Court (Specified Offences) (Accomplices) Order, 1957.

2. Where under the provisions of section 40 of the Criminal Procedure Law a person (hereinafter referred to as "the accomplice") may be joined in one charge and may be tried together with a person who is charged with a specified offence, which specified offence is, by virtue of section 9A of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to (No. 2) 1956, within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Special Court, the offence with which the accomplice may be so charged is hereby prescribed to be a specified offence for the purposes of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to (No. 2) 1956.

## THE MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) LAW, 1954.
