THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CONTROL OF BUILDING OPERATIONS) (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER REGULATION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 7 of the Emergency Powers (Control of Building Operations) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased, subject to the conditions stated below, to exempt the following classes of buildings from the provisions of the Regulations :—

- (1) Hotels and Open Air Cinemas.
- (2) Buildings to be erected within any area defined under Regulation 7 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulations upon sites—
  - (a) the buildings on which are or have been the subject of any notice under section 140 of the Municipal Corporations Law, or of an Order under section 15 of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, or in respect of which a demolition permit has been issued prior to the 1st day of January, 1957, under section 3 (1) (b) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law ;
  - (b) which are vacant :
