THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT)
LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF YEROSKIPOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Yeroskipos hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos Bye-laws, 1951 to 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos Bye-laws, 1951 to 1957.

2. Bye-law 117 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion from item (a) of the figures "£1.500" and the substitution therefor of the figures "£2.750".

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1956), is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of items 3, 9, 10, 21, 22, 23, 25, 31, 35, 39, 44, 45, 47, 48, 51, 53, and the substitution therefor of the following items :—
