THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.REVOCATION OF ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 64.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), His Excellency the Governor hereby revokes the Order made by him under Defence Regulation 64 and published under Notification No. 774 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 15th August, 1956 (as extended by Notification No. 74 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 31st January, 1957) without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
