THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC LAW, 1954.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Law, 1954, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Drivers Hours of Work) (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Drivers Hours of Work) Regulations, 1955, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Drivers Hours of Work) Regulations, 1955 and 1957.

Regulation 4 (2) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words and punctuation "or any police officer specially authorized by the Chief Constable in this respect," appearing in the second and third lines thereof and substituting therefor the words "or any police officer".
