THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to me to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorize its use in the interest of public order and safety :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, which I have been authorized to exercise under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Paphos have taken possession of the land with effect from 1st January, 1957, and, in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, I hereby direct and order as follows :—

- (1) The use of the land for the requirements of Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorized.
- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorized to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.
- (3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately owned land at Stroumbi Village, Paphos District, being Plots 481/3/2 and part of Plots 481/1/1, 478/1 and 477 on the Government Survey Plan XLV.13 and more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Commissioner of Paphos and dated 20th June, 1957, a copy of which is available at the Office of the Commissioner of Paphos.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)

DIRECTIONS MADE UNDER REGULATION 33 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 33 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, and delegated to me by Notification No. 735 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia, do hereby direct that in order to facilitate the operations of the Cyprus Police Force, the road in Kyrenia known as THYSSEOS STREET from its junction with DIGHENIS AKRITAS STREET to its intersection with ISTIM BEY STREET be closed to all pedestrian and other traffic until further notice.
