## THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

### ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Kyrenia District

No. K 37) Order, 1957.

2. No person within the village area of KHARCHA shall be out of doors between the hours of 05.30 and 08.30 on Sunday the 23rd of June, 1957, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area.

3. Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.
