THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.
CAP. 92 AND LAWS 16 OF 1954 AND 21 OF 1957.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 5A.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (2) of section 5A of the Foreshore Protection Law (as contained in the Foreshore Protection (Amendment) Law, 1957) the Governor has been pleased to make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Foreshore Protection (Forms and Fees) Order, 1957.
2. A permit granted by a Commissioner under sub-section (1) of section 5A of the Foreshore Protection Law shall be in the form contained in Part I of the Schedule to this Order.
3. The conditions under which a Commissioner may grant to any person a permit under sub-section (1) of section 5A of the Foreshore Protection Law shall be those contained in Part II of the Schedule to this Order and such conditions shall be printed on the reverse side of each permit granted.
4. The following shall be the fees which shall be paid by any person for a permit granted to him to remove stones, shingle, sand, gravel or any other substance from the foreshore under sub-section (1) of section 5A of the Foreshore Protection Law :—
 - (i) To remove one load by lorry or tractor 500 mils.
 - (ii) To remove any number of loads by cart for one week . . . 120 mils.
 - (iii) To remove any number of loads by cart for one month . . . 500 mils.

PART II.

CONDITIONS OF ISSUE.

1. No sand, gravel or stones dug under this permit shall be removed outside.....District without the written authority of the Commissioner,.....
2. No sand, gravel or stones shall be removed in any vehicle except the one specified in the Permit.
3. No sand, gravel or stones shall be dug except from the site indicated by any Watchman or other person authorised for this purpose by the Commissioner.
4. The holder of this Permit must obey the instructions of any Watchman or other person authorised for this purpose by the Commissioner, relating to the manner, place and time of removing sand, gravel or stones from the Foreshore.
5. The holder of this Permit shall produce it at once if requested to do so by a Police Officer, a Watchman or other person authorised for this purpose by the Commissioner.
6. No sand gravel or stones shall be removed between 11 a.m. on Saturdays and sunrise on the following Monday, except by permit holders using carts.
7. No sand, gravel or stones shall be dug or collected by agents or labourers of the holder of this permit before sunrise or after sunset.
8. No vehicle shall enter the Foreshore between the hours of sunset and sunrise for the purpose of extracting or collecting sand, gravel or stones.
9. Any unauthorised alteration, erasure or addition to this permit (which is an official document) shall render it invalid.

 ORDER MADE UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 55.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 55, as set out in the Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956, His Excellency the Governor, by this Order, hereby prohibits the use of any motor vehicle on any road in the area set out in the Schedule hereto.
