

No. 80.**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 17) 1956.****ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.**

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 17) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 26th November, 1955, I, Warren Frederick Martin Clemens, Commissioner of Nicosia, do hereby give notice that in the interests of public order and safety and for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community, have taken possession with immediate effect of the land specified in the Schedule hereto until further notice.

2. The use of the said land to be used as playing field, is hereby authorized.

3. The authority using the land in pursuance of this Order is entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes of their occupation.

4. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

All the privately owned land in Orta Keuy village, Nicosia District, that is to say:—

The area shown under plot No. 83 (part) of the Government Survey Plan Sheet XXI.37.E.2, Block D, all which said area is more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings, Cyprus, and dated the 14th January, 1957, a copy of which is deposited in the Office of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, at Nicosia.

No. 81.**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 17) 1956.****ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.**

Whereas it appears to me to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorise its use in the interest of public order and safety:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 17) 1956, which I have been authorised to exercise under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Limassol, hereby take possession of the land and, in connection with the taking, possession and making use of the land, I hereby direct and order as follows:—

(1) The use of the land for the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer is hereby authorised.

- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorised to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.
- (3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

That part of the Plots in the area of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol described hereunder comprising all land within 25 feet of the centre of the circle shown coloured red on the Plans signed by me and deposited in the Commissioner's Office, as follows:—

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 17) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 17) 1956, and delegated to me under Notification No. 736, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, Omer Faik Muftizadé, Commissioner of Paphos, do order as follows:—

1. I authorize, subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the taking, possession and the use by the security forces (which expression shall include Her Majesty's Forces and Cyprus Police Force) of the property specified in the Second Schedule during the period of one year as from the 12th December, 1956.
2. The persons using the property in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary to the proper functioning of the security forces during the period during which this Order shall remain in force.
3. The exercise of any right of way over the property and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the property or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The property shall be occupied and used only in pursuance of the duties performed by the security forces.
2. At the expiration of this Order the property shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto free of any erections, structures or constructions erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.
3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest on the land for its use and occupation under this Order.
