## No. 829. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW.

CAP. 252 AND LAWS 11 OF 1950, 31 OF 1951, 20 OF 1953, 29 OF 1954, 57 OF 1954 AND 14 OF 1955.

Bye-laws made by the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Larnaca.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Larnaca hereby make the following bye-laws:—	
1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Larnaca Municipal (Amendment) (No. 2) Bye-laws, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Larnaca Municipal Bye-laws, 1949 to 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these Bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Larnaca) Bye-laws, 1949 to (No. 2) 1957.	Suppl. No. 3: 9. 9.1949 16. 4 1952
2. Paragraph 1 of bye-law 74 of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Larnaca Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1957, is hereby repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—	
Mils.	
"1.—(a) (i) For every bull, calf, camel, cow or ox not exceeding 20 okes in weight 300	
(ii) if exceeding 20 okes in weight then in addition to the above fee, for every additional oke or part thereof	
<ul> <li>(b) for every goat or sheep</li></ul>	
(d) for every kid slaughtered between the 1st May and	
the 31st October of any year	
following year 125	
(f) For every lamb slaughtered between the 1st March and the 31st October of any year	
(g) (i) for every pig not exceeding 10 okes in weight 150	
(ii) for every pig exceeding 10 okes in weight but not exceeding 20 okes in weight 300	
(iii) if exceeding 20 okes in weight, then in addition to the above fees for each additional oke or	
part thereof 15".	

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 1085/49/3.)
