NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 505 in the *Gazette* of 3rd May, 1956, as amended by Notice No. 565 published in the *Gazette* of 9th May, 1957, it is hereby notified for general information that, after considering the plans and specifications concerning the streets enumerated under column (1) of the Schedule hereto no objections having been made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve the plans and specifications concerning the said streets to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the conditions shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Nicosia and upon all owners affected.

No. 850. THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF KOPHINOI.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Kophinou hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kophinou (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kophinou Bye-laws, 1953 and 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kophinou Bye-laws, 1953 to 1957.

2. The Second Schedule (Bye-law 177) to the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kophinou (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1956), is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of items 7 and 8 and the substitution therefor of the following items :—

<i>"Item No.</i>	<i>Goods.</i>	<i>Minimum weight. Okes</i>	<i>Fees. Mils.</i>	<i>Fees for any quantity in excess of the minimum weight. Mils per 10 okes or part thereof :</i>
