THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by virtue of the Orders, a list of which appears in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the Orders"), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use for military purposes of the lands and properties set out in the Second Schedule to the Orders (hereinafter referred to as "the lands"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas the Orders were subsequently extended, on the dates appearing in the Third Column of the Schedule hereto, for a period of six months from the expiration thereof, hereinafter referred to as "the extending orders";

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the lands should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorizations for using the lands for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Orders be continued for a further period of six months as from the date of the expiration of the extending orders and the Orders are hereby extended accordingly.
