THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 15th October, 1955, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 17th October, 1955, under Notification No. 631 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Eylenja (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 292, 1164 and 390 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 12th April, 1956, 29th November, 1956 and 11th April, 1957, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 14th October, 1957 ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 15th October, 1957, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

Whereas by Order dated the 19th October, 1955, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 20th October, 1955, under Notification No. 637 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Pedhoulas village, in the District of Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as "the land") subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 294, 1164 and 392 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 12th April, 1956, 29th November, 1956 and 11th April, 1957 respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 18th October, 1957 ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force.

**No. 915. THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1956), His Excellency the Governor by this Order, orders as follows :—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of six months from the date of this Order is hereby authorized.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.

2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.

3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest on the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All the privately owned property situated at Mehmed Akif Street, Ayios Andreas Quarter, Nicosia, known as the "Ex-Tamwy Building" with all buildings erected thereon and appurtenances thereto, and shown as part of Plot 62 on the Government Survey Sheet Plan XXI.46.IV (Block 30), more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings, Cyprus, dated 28th September, 1957, and deposited in the Commissioner's Office, Nicosia.
