## THE FAMAGUSTA WATER BOARD REGULATIONS, 1952 AND 1956.

It is hereby notified for the information of consumers of water in Famagusta town that in pursuance of regulation 10 of the Famagusta Water Board Regulations, 1952 and 1956, the Famagusta Water Board have fixed the following water rates for 1957:—

- 1. By Water Meter:
  - (i) Up to 10 tons per month, whether consumed or not, a minimum charge of 335 mils per month.
  - (ii) Over 10 and not more than 20 tons per month, the minimum charge plus 50 mils per ton for any additional tons above 10 and not more than 20 tons.
  - (iii) Over 20 tons per month, the corresponding charges for the first tons, as laid down at (i) and (ii) above, plus 70 mils per ton for the remaining tons.
- 2. By "Sakorafi":
  - (i) For the first privately owned "sakorafi", £24.
  - (ii) For every privately owned "sakorafi" in excess of one in the same premises, £36.
- 3. Special rates:
  - (i) War Department, Hotels and Industry: Any quantity per month below 100 tons at the rates as in paragraph 1.
  - (ii) 100 tons and over per month, 55 mils per ton.
  - (iii) Ships:

200 mils per ton. Rigging of hose 500 mils.

In pursuance of regulation II of the said Regulations the Board have decided that all the rates shall be paid quarterly.
