

And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia, by notice published under No. 862 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 12th September, 1957, gave particulars of the land required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking of public utility (hereinafter referred to as "the land");

And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plan and particulars in connection with the land, no objections to the proposed acquisition having been made;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor has been pleased to sanction the acquisition under the provisions of the said Law, of the land.

**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

**AMENDMENT OF ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE  
REGULATION 64.**
