THE IRRIGATION CHARGES REGULATIONS, 1931 TO 1951.

NOTIFICATION UNDER REGULATION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by regulation 2 of the Irrigation Charges Regulations, 1931 to 1951, I do hereby prescribe that a charge of 300 mils per donum for every watering shall be levied on and paid by any person making use of water from the water-works known as the Eastern Messaoria Irrigation Works, for the watering of any kind of crop, except cotton, specified in the first column of the Schedule to the said Regulations.

2. The Notification published under No. 420 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st July, 1956, is amended accordingly.

THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF KORNOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Kornos hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kornos (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kornos Bye-laws, 1953 and 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Kornos Bye-laws, 1953 to 1957.

2. The Second Schedule (Bye-law 177) to the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of items 7 and 8 and the substitution therefor of the following:—

"Item No.	Goods	Minimum weight. Okes	Fees Mils	Fees for any quantity in excess of the minimum weight. Mils per 10 okes or part thereof.
7.	Carobs, natural or ground	45	7	2 per 15 okes or part thereof.
8.	Carobs, natural or ground, on exportation	45	7	2 per 15 okes or part thereof."

The above Bye-laws have been approved by the Administrative Secretary. (M.P. 1650/52.)
