THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,
1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment of the Criminal Code) (No. 2) Regulations, 1957.

2. During the continuance in force of these Regulations, the Criminal Code shall be read and construed as if at the end of section 57 thereof there were added the following :—

“For the purposes of this section the expression ‘lawful authority’ shall include authority given by the Government.”

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2971

MADE UNDER SECTION 124 (1).

*Authority to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia
to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 124 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. The Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as “the Municipal Corporation”) shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as “the Lender”) the sum of thirty-five thousand pounds (£35,000) at a rate of interest not exceeding four and a half per centum ($4\frac{1}{2}\%$) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the Lender in twenty equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest), the first instalment being payable one year after the last withdrawal ;
- (b) the Municipal Corporation shall, in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the annual sum payable as aforesaid in the year to which such estimates relate ;

- (c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Municipal Corporation for the acquisition of land in the Ayios Antonios quarter, Nicosia, for the erection of a wholesale market for perishable goods ;
- (d) no issues from the loan shall be made by the Lender to the Municipal Corporation except—
- (i) against a certificate of registration proving the purchase of the land ; and
 - (ii) if there is any balance from the loan after purchase of the land, which the Municipal Corporation wish to use for constructional works in connection with the market, against certificates of completed works issued by the Director of Public Works : Provided that if the said balance is over £1,000, drawings from the Lender should be for amounts of £1,000 at any one time, or multiples thereof.

2. For the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.

THE SOIL CONSERVATION LAWS, 1952 AND 1956.

ORDER OF SUPERSESSION OF THE BOARD OF THE SOIL CONSERVATION OF
"GAMELA" (LEFKONIKO, YENAGRA, PSILLATOS), IN THE DISTRICT
OF FAMAGUSTA.

Whereas it has been made to appear to the Governor that the Board of the Soil Conservation Division of "Gamela" (Lefkoniko, Yenagra, Psillatos), in the District of Famagusta, is not discharging its duties properly ;

And whereas His Excellency the Governor is satisfied that the said Board is not discharging its duties properly ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 29 of the Soil Conservation Laws, 1952 and 1956 His Excellency the Governor hereby orders that the said Board be, and it is hereby, dissolved and the following persons are hereby appointed to manage the affairs of the Soil Conservation Division of "Gamela" (Lefkoniko, Yenagra, Psillatos) for the unexpired period of office of the said Board until the 21st May, 1958 :—

Mr. Salih Osman, Temporary Administrative Assistant, 3rd Grade.
