ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 21 (1)

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section 1 of section 21 of the Dangerous Drugs Law, 1956, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. The persons whose names appear in the first column of the Schedule hereto are hereby authorised to exercise within the district specified in the third column of the said Schedule against the name of each such person, all the powers conferred upon persons so authorised by sub-section 1 of section 21 of the aforesaid Law.
