THE PRISON DISCIPLINE LAW. CAP. 266 AND LAW 1 OF 1953.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Prison Cap. 266. Discipline Law, His Excellency the Acting Governor, with the advice of 1 of 1953 the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prison (Temporary Provisions) Regulations, 1957.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Prison Regulations, the S.L. Vol. I, Governor may, if he considers it expedient so to do in the interests of p. 565. maintaining discipline and order in a prison or in the public interest generally, direct the removal of a prisoner from a prison to a police prison for the purpose of serving the remainder of his sentence, or such part thereof as the Governor may direct, in such police prison.
- 3. These Regulations shall remain in force for a period of one year from the date hereof and shall then expire.

THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 28) Order, 1957.
- 2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 24th day of October, 1957.
