The area of the territorial waters of Cyprus bounded by a line drawn round the circumference of a circle of 3,000 yards radius with a centre in the position 34° 38′ 07″ N., 32° 51′ 43″ E. and by the limit of the territorial waters where that limit is within the area of the aforesaid circle.

No. 997. THE BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS LAW. CAP. 222 AND LAW 23 OF 1951.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 3 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, His Excellency the Acting Governor hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Bombardment Range Areas (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Bombardment Range Areas (Consolidation) Regulations, 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").
- 2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after regulation 28 of the following regulations:—

"The Episkopi Bombardment Range Area.

- 29. In this part of these Regulations the 'Episkopi Bombardment Range Area' means the area declared as such under section 2 of the Law by notice published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th November, 1957, or by any other notice amending or substituted for the same.
- 30. The danger signals to be hoisted in respect of the Episkopi Bombardment Range Area shall be as follows:—

(a) By Day:

(i) Red flags hoisted on the plotting huts positioned at 34° 39′ 50″ N, 32° 50′ 40″ E and at 34° 39′ 20″ N, 32° 53′ 05″ E.

(b) By Night:

- (i) Red lights displayed on plotting huts mentioned in (a) (i) above.
- 31. Regulation '29' of the principal Regulations is hereby renumbered '31'."
