ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District) (No. 25) Order, 1958.

2. No Greek Cypriot male or female born between the 1st January, 1932, and the 1st January, 1944, both days inclusive, shall be out of doors within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto, between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Limassol or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force on duty.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 19th day of November, 1958, and shall remain in force until further notice.

Within the village boundaries of Kolossi and Erimi.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 1700 hours until 0600 hours.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Famagusta District 54) Order, 1958.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Famagusta or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to :--

(a) any member of the Executive Council;

(b) any member of Her Majesty's Forces or of the Cyprus Police Force (which term for the purposes of this Order includes the Auxiliary Police Force and the Police Fire Service) and any Special Constable when on duty as such ;
