ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3056

MADE UNDER SECTION 60 (d).

Whereas by the Unlawful Association (Inkilapçi) Order, 1955, which was published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 14th December, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), the body of persons responsible for the publication of the newspaper "Inkilapçi" was declared, under paragraph (d) of section 60 of the Criminal Code, to have among its Cap. 13 aims the promotion of disorder and of the spread of sedition within the 27 of 1949 Colony and to be proscribed within the Colony:

12 of 1951 28 of 1952 4 of 1953

And whereas it is provided, inter alia, under the said paragraph (d) of section 60 of the Criminal Code that any such order made under the said 28 of 1954 paragraph shall remain in force for a period of twelve months from the date 20 of 1955 of its publication in the Gazette and no longer unless renewed for such further 27 of 1958. period or periods, not exceeding twelve months at any one time, as the Governor in Council may direct by order published in the Gazette:

And whereas the principal Order was renewed for a period of twelve months as from the 14th December, 1956, and for a further period of twelve months as from the 14th December, 1957:

And whereas it is considered desirable to renew the principal Order for a further period of twelve months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (d) of section 60 of the Criminal Code, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Unlawful Association (Inkilapçi) (Renewal) Order, 1958.
- 2. The Unlawful Association (Inkilapçi) Order, 1955, is hereby renewed for a further period of twelve months as from the 14th December, 1958, inclusive.
