In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of the Defence (Importa- Gazettes : tion of Goods) Regulations, 1956, I hereby grant to any importer registered Supplement under the provisions of the Defence (Registration of Importers) Order, 1956, No. 3: 10. 5.1956 an Open Import Licence under No. 24444 to import into the Colony in any quantity any of the goods enumerated in the Schedule hereto and originating in any of the following countries and exported from such country of origin :-

(a) Canada;

(b) The American Account Area, that is to say : The United States of America, and any territory under the sovereignty of the United States of America ; Pacific Islands formerly under Japanese administration but now under United States administration; the Philippine Islands; Bolivia, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuator, Guatemala, Haiti, Republic of Honduras, Liberia, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, El Salvador and Venezuela:

Provided that in all cases covered by this licence payment for the goods shall be made, through banking channels, either-

(i) in sterling to an American or Canadian Account ; or

(ii) in U.S.A. or Canadian Dollars.

2. This Open Import Licence is deemed to be a written licence issued by me under regulation 3 (1) (a) of the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1956, and is subject to the provisions of regulation 3 (1) (b)of the said Regulations.

3. This Open Import Licence shall come into effect on the 1st January, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Open Import Licence which comes into effect on the 1st January, 1959 liberalises the import of a wide range of dollar goods which, in view of foreign exchange considerations, were hitherto restricted.

The import of many goods included in this Open Import Licence is subject to a permit under the hand of the Director of Agriculture or other appropriate Authority as the case may be. The fact that any such goods are included in this Open Import Licence does not mean that import will be permitted unless the importer holds the necessary permit from the Appropriate Authority.

NOTICE (No. 28) UNDER CLAUSE 3 OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by clause 3 of the First Schedule to the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1956, I, the Director of Commerce and Industry, do hereby declare that the import into the Colony by any importer registered under the provisions of the Defence (Registration of Importers) Order, 1956, of the goods shown in the List hereunder from Yugoslavia, is hereby permitted without a written licence under Regulation 3 (1) (a) of the above named Regulations, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

(a) that the goods enumerated in the List hereunder originate in Yugoslavia and are imported from such country of origin;

- (b) that payment for such goods shall be made in sterling, through banking channels; and
- (c) that such goods shall be cleared from Customs on or before the 31st December, 1959.
