NOTICE (No. 29) UNDER CLAUSE 3 OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by clause 3 of the First Schedule to the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1956, I, the Director of Commerce and Industry, do hereby declare that the import into the Colony by any importer registered under the provisions of the Defence (Registration of Importers) Order, 1956, of the goods shown in the List hereunder is hereby permitted without a written licence under regulation 3 (1) (a) of the above named Regulations, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) That, unless the contrary is stated in the List hereunder, such goods shall originate in any of the following countries and shall be imported from such country of origin, that is to say, the United Kingdom, any British Colony, Australia, New Zealand, Union of South Africa, India, Pakistan, Ceylon, Irish Republic, Austria, Belgium (including overseas dependent territories), Denmark, France (including overseas dependent territories), Greece, German Federal Republic, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands (including overseas dependent territories), Norway, Portugal (including overseas dependent territories), Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Sudan, Syria.
- (b) That payment for such goods shall be made either—

(i) in sterling; or

- (ii) in the case of goods imported from a country whose currency is specified under the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1957, or any Order amending or replacing the same, in the currency of such country.
- 2. This Notice shall come into effect on the 1st January, 1959.
