THE BURIALS LAW.
CAP. 53 AND LAW 33 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 15.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 617 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 12th December, 1951, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the District Lands Office for use as a burial-ground by the Orthodox-Christian community of the village of Trakhonas, in the District of Nicosia :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 15 of the Burials Law, and duly delegated to me under Notification No. 172, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I do hereby order that from and after the 15th December, 1958, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burial-ground referred to above has been provided.

THE QUARANTINE LAW.
CAP. 145.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, Cap. 145, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares that Local Areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subjected to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine (Maritime and Aerial) Regulations, 1953 to 1958, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the said Schedule.

The Notification No. 86 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th February, 1958, is hereby cancelled.
