

No. 1130. THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 7th August, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 10th August, 1956, under Notification No. 766 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Kyrenia Road, Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 74, 748 and 59, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 31st January, 1957, 1st August, 1957 and 6th February, 1958, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 6th August, 1958 :

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1958), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of six months as from the 7th August, 1958.

THE MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) LAWS, 1954 AND 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Law, 1954, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurers) (Amendment) Order, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurers) Order, 1957, as from time to time amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of "Le Phenix-Accidents Société Anonyme d'Assurances et de Reassurances" from the Schedule thereto.
