THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC LAWS,
1954 AND 1957.

(LAWS 61 OF 1954 AND 35 OF 1957.)

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3057

MADE UNDER SUB-SECTION (2) OF SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (2) of section 2 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Laws, 1954 and 1957, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Schedule of Fees) Order, 1958.

2. The Schedule to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Laws, 1954 and 1957, is hereby varied by deleting the whole Schedule aforesaid and by substituting therefor the following Schedule :—

“ SCHEDULE.

(Section 3.)

PART I.

A.—REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES.	£ mils.
For a motor vehicle	3.000
For a motor cycle	1.500

B.—LICENCES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

(a) For a motor vehicle, driven by a petrol engine, the tare of which—	<i>Per annum</i> £ <i>mils.</i>
(i) does not exceed 5 cwt.	2.250
(ii) exceeds 5 cwt. and does not exceed 10 cwt. . .	4.250
(iii) exceeds 10 cwt. and does not exceed 15 cwt. . .	6.500
(iv) exceeds 15 cwt. and does not exceed 20 cwt. . .	7.500
(v) exceeds 20 cwt. and does not exceed 25 cwt. . .	8.500
(vi) exceeds 25 cwt.	13.000

Provided that where a licence is issued for a part of the half-yearly or yearly period and the motor vehicle has not been used on the roads during the other part of such period there shall be paid only a proportionate fee in respect of the unexpired part of such period still to run, the whole of the month in which the application is made being counted as part of the unexpired period.

(b) For a motor vehicle, driven by an engine, other than a petrol engine, the tare of which—	
(i) does not exceed 50 cwt.	90.000

Provided that where a licence is issued for a part of the half-yearly or yearly period and the motor vehicle has not been used on the roads during the other part of such period there shall be paid only a proportionate fee in respect of the unexpired part of such period still to run, the whole of the month in which the application is made being counted as part of the unexpired period :

Provided further that the licence fee in respect of a half-yearly period shall be	45.000
(ii) exceeds 50 cwt.	108.000

Provided that where a licence is issued for a part of the half-yearly or yearly period and the motor vehicle has not been used on the roads during the other part of such period there shall be paid only a proportionate fee in respect of the unexpired part of such period still to run, the whole of the month in which the application is made being counted as part of the unexpired period :

Provided further that the licence fee in respect of a half-yearly period shall be	54.000
(c) For every motor cycle with or without a side-car	2.250
(d) For every duplicate licence issued to motor vehicles or motor cycles	0.250

PART II.

(a) For every test	0.750
(b) For a licence to drive a motor vehicle	0.750
(c) For defaced licences and photographs	0.250."

NOTE.—The above fees do not include any special duty payable under the Documents (Special Duty) Law, Cap. 293.
