4. Any person who-

- (a) contravenes or fails to comply with any direction given under paragraph (1) of regulation 3; or
- (b) fails to supply any information requested under paragraph (3) of regulation 3, of these Regulations

shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years or to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to both such fine and such imprisonment.
