THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC LAW, 1954 AND

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Motor Vehicles 61 of 1954 and Road Traffic Law, 1954 and 1957, His Excellency the Governor, with the 35 of 1957. advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations :-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Gazettes: Regulations, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles Regulations, 1951 to (No. 2) 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Motor Vehicles Regulations, 1951 to 1958.

2. Regulation 61 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the Substitution following regulations to be numbered "61" and "61A" substituted there- of Regulafor :—

" Offences.

61. Any person who contravenes any of these regulations shall

be guilty of an offence against these regulations.

Offences under Regulations and municipal bye-laws.

61A.—(1) Where an act or omission constitutes an offence under these regulations and also under any bye-law made by any Municipal Authority, the offender shall be liable to be prosecuted and punished either under these regulations or under such byelaws, but shall not be liable to be punished twice for the same offence.

(2) Where any person is adjudged by any Court to pay any fine in respect of an offence against these regulations committed within any municipal limits, such fine shall be paid to the town fund of the municipal corporation concerned.".

THE RENT (CONTROL) LAWS, 1954 AND 1955.
