THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1957.

REVOCATION OF ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957, His Excellency the Governor hereby revokes the Order made under Emergency Regulation 44 and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 11th April, 1957, under Notification 405, without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 20th October, 1955, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 24th October, 1955, under Notification No. 649 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Trypiotis Quarter, Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 295, 1164, 394 and 910 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 12th April, 1956, 29th November, 1956, 11th April, 1957 and 3rd October, 1957, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 19th April, 1958 ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 20th April, 1958, and the Order is so extended accordingly.
