THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 16th March, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 22nd March, 1956, under Notification No. 216 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Pano Platres, Limassol District (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 969, 219 and 858 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazettes of the 11th October, 1956, 28th February, 1957 and 12th September, 1957, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 15th March, 1958;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 16th March, 1958, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

THE WELLS LAW.

CAP. 312 AND LAWS 19 OF 1951 AND 42 OF 1953.

Notice under Section 3A (2).

Whereas His Excellency the Governor, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such areas under section 3A of the Wells Law:

Now, therefore, by the direction of His Excellency the Governor notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the office of the Commissioner of the District in which the area affected is situated during office hours and free of charge during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the *Gazette* and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Commissioner of the District in which the area affected is situated, object to the making of the Order.
