THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 16th March, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 22nd March, 1956, under Notification No. 216 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Pano Platres, Limassol District (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 969, 219 and 858 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazettes of the 11th October, 1956, 28th February, 1957 and 12th September, 1957, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 15th March, 1958;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Gazette: Supplement No, 2A: 9.12.1957. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the 16th March, 1958, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

THE WELLS LAW.

CAP. 312 AND LAWS 19 OF 1951 AND 42 OF 1953.

Notice under Section 3A (2).

Whereas His Excellency the Governor, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such areas under section 3A of the Wells Law:

Now, therefore, by the direction of His Excellency the Governor notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the office of the Commissioner of the District in which the area affected is situated during office hours and free of charge during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the *Gazette* and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Commissioner of the District in which the area affected is situated, object to the making of the Order.

SCHEDULE.

Defined Area.

In the villages of Morphou, Khrysiliou, Kalokhorio (Kapouti), Kyra, Argaki, Katokopia, Masari, Philia, Dhenia, Kokkini Trimithia, Avlona, Astromeritis, Pano Zodhia, Kato Zodhia, Nikitas, Prastion, Pendayia, Elea, Petra, Angolemi, Kato Koutraphas, Potami, Peristerona, Orounda, Meniko, Akaki and Paleometokho, in the district of Nicosia, the area within the following boundary, that is to say:—

The boundary commences at a point where it is cut by the straight line from forest cairn No. 195 of the Ayia Irini Main State Forest to the most northern point of plot No. 109 of Block "K" of Ayios Yeoryios Quarter, Morphou Village, which point is on the left bank of the "River Aloupos" and proceeds eastwards along the said bank of the said river to its junction with a stream, which junction is at the most western point of plot No. 27 of the Government Survey Plan No. X.64; thence southeastwards along the said stream to the most southern point of plot No. 29 of the said plan, which point is on a footpath leading to the village of Kalokhorio (Kapouti); thence in an easterly direction along the said footpath to its junction with the Morphou-Dhiorios main road, which junction is at the north-eastern corner of plot No. 419 of the Government Survey Plan No. XX.2, locality "Selladhin"; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 62 of the said plan, which point is on the village road leading from the village of Kalokhorio (Kapouti) to the village of Kyra; thence in a south-easterly direction along the said village road to the most southern point of plot No. 43 of the Government Survey Plan No. XX.27; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the most northern point of plot No. 163 of the said plan; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the Government Survey triangulation point No. 45/4 on the said plan; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the most western point of plot No. 299 of the said plan, which point is on the village road leading from the village of Kyra to the village of Philia; thence south-eastwards along the said village road to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 178 of the Government Survey Plan No. XX.36, locality "Ayia Petra"; thence southwards in a straight line to the Government Survey triangulation point No. 91/4 on the said plan; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 640 of the said plan; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the Government Survey triangulation point No. 90/4 on the said plan; thence northwards in a straight line to the most western point of plot No. 518 of the said plan, which point is on the village road leading from the village of Philia to the village of Yerolakkos; thence eastwards along the said village road to the north-western corner of the Water Conservation Area, the boundaries of which were published under Notification No. 556 (item 1) of Supplement No. 3 to the Cyprus Gazette of 1951; thence southwards and south-eastwards along the western boundary of the said Water Conservation Area to the south-western corner of plot No. 646 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.8, locality "Anephani"; thence south-westwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 462 of the said plan, which corner is on a track leading from the village of Paleometokho to the village of Meniko; thence south-westwards along the said track to the most southern point of plot No. 1212 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.14, locality "Monastirkotika"; thence north-westwards in a straight line to the Government Survey triangulation point No. 256/4 on the said plan; thence south-westwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 1346 of the said plan, which corner is on a track leading from the village of Meniko to the village of Orounda; thence south-westwards along the said track to the south-western

corner of plot No. 724 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.20, locality "Kokkinopetra"; thence north-westwards in a straight line to the most southern point of plot No. 194 of the said plan; thence south-westwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 317 of the said plan, which corner is on a track leading from the village of Orounda to the village of Potami; thence in a westerly direction along the said track to its junction with another track, which junction is at the most western point of plot No. 159 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.18 thence north-westwards in a straight line to the Government Survey triangulation point No. 139/4 on the said plan; thence westwards in a straight line to the most southern point of plot No. 24 of the said plan which point is on a road leading from the village of Potami to the Nicosia-Lefka main road; thence north-westwards along the said road to the said main road; thence in a westerly direction along the said main road to the mile post No. 27; thence westwards in a straight line to the north-western corner of plot No. 89 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXVIII.4, locality "Marathies", which corner is on the most southern point of the Water Conservation Area, the boundaries of which were published under Notification No. 1052 of Supplement No. 3 to the Cyprus Gazette of 1956; thence north-eastwards and northwards along the eastern boundary of the said Water Conservation Area to the point of commencement, all which boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1700 signed by the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia bearing date 23rd January, 1958, and deposited at the Office of the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia.

No. 170. THE MISSIONARY EDUCATIONAL AND MEDICAL (ALIEN REGULATION) LAW, CAP. 124.

PERMIT UNDER SECTION 8.

Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of the Missionary Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Law, the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto have applied for permits under the provisons of the said Law:

And whereas the said persons have severally given an undertaking in writing to pay all due obedience and respect to the Government of Cyprus and, while carefully abstaining from participation in political affairs, that they desire and purpose *ex animo* to work in friendly co-operation with the said Government in all matters in which their influence might properly be exerted; and, they have undertaken that, if engaged in educational work, their influence will be exerted to promote loyalty to the Government of Cyprus in the minds of their pupils and to make them good citizens of the British Empire:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Missionary, Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to grant to the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto a permit respectively to commence or carry on the work set down after their respective names.
