REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 5 of the Elementary Cap. 203. Education Law, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to make and hereby 22 of 1950 kes the following Regulations:—

(Qualification and Registration of Schoolteachers) Regulations, 1958.

2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires:—

"Director" means the Director of Education;

"Law" means the Elementary Education Law and includes any regulations made thereunder and relating to the qualifications and registration of teachers;

"Register" means the Permanent Staff Register required to be kept 12 of 1954

"Biggister and the provisions of section 22 of the Law: 19 of 1955 by the Director under the provisions of section 32 of the Law;

"Temporary Staff Register" means the Temporary Staff Register required to be kept by the Director under the provisions of section 37 of the Law.

3. No person shall hereafter be registered as a teacher on the Permanent Staff Register unless, in addition to possessing all other qualifications which may be required by the Law or by any Regulation made thereunder, he-

(a) has been admitted to the Teachers' Training College and has successfully finished a course of training in the College; or

(b) is a graduate of any institution considered by the Director as equivalent to the Teachers' Training College, Cyprus:

Provided however that any teacher who, though he does not possess the prescribed academic qualifications, has served continuously as a temporary teacher in elementary schools in Cyprus for a period of not less than ten years and who in the opinion of the Director has reached a satisfactory standard of efficiency in practical teaching may, with the approval of the Governor, be transferred to the Permanent Staff on the successful completion of a special course approved by the Director.

- 4. No person shall hereafter be registered as a temporary teacher on the Temporary Staff Register unless, in addition to possessing all other qualifications which may be required by the Law or by any Regulation made thereunder-
 - (a) he is qualified for registration on the Permanent Staff Register but is not so registered because of no vacancy in the Permanent Staff or because of other considerations; or

(b) he has finished a full secondary school course, and has previous service as a teacher:

Provided that the Director may appoint as temporary teachers, for such periods as do not exceed one year at a time, persons who have completed a secondary education but have no previous service as a teacher.

5. The Elementary Education (Classification and Promotion of Teachers) Gazette: Regulations, 1939, are hereby revoked.
