Nomination of Member to the Water Board of Nicosia by the Municipal Council of Nicosia.

It is hereby notified that in exercise of the powers vested in it under section 4 (b) of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 to 1954, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia has nominated Dr. Themistocles Dervis, O.B.E., Mayor of Nicosia, to hold office on the Water Board of Nicosia during the Council's term of office in the place of Mr. Husseyin Irfan who has resigned from the office of Councillor and consequently has ceased to be a member of the said Water Board.

THE WATER SUPPLY (MUNICIPAL AND OTHER AREAS) LAWS, 1951 TO 1954.

Amendment of the Authority granted to the Water Board of Nicosia to contract a loan of £330,000 from the Loan Commissioners at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum.

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 23 of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 to 1954, and of any other power enabling him in that behalf, has consented to the above authority, which was published under notification No. 496 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Cyprus Gazette* of the 1st October, 1953, being amended by the deletion of the terms and conditions set out therein and the substitution therefor of the following terms and conditions:—

(a) The sum borrowed shall be withdrawn in instalments in multiples of £1,000 and shall be utilized by the Board for general purposes connected with the Nicosia Water Supply Scheme including the purchase of pipes and equipment required by it.

(b) All interest at 4% per annum which will accrue on withdrawals shall on the final withdrawals be capitalised.

(c) The sum borrowed plus the capitalised interest shall be repayable by the Board in twenty-seven (27) equal annual instalments (comprising capital and interest), the first instalment to become payable on the 23rd March, 1956, and all subsequent instalments on the same date in the years following.
