It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 23 of the Water Supply (Municipal and Other Areas) Laws, 1951 to 1954, and of any other power enabling him in that behalf, has consented to the above authority, which was published under notification No. 429 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Cyprus Gazette* of the 22nd August, 1951, being amended by the deletion of the terms and conditions set out therein and the substitution therefor of the following terms and conditions:—

(a) The sum borrowed shall be withdrawn in instalments in multiples of £1,000 and shall be utilised by the Board for general purposes connected with the Nicosia Water Supply Scheme including the purchase of pipes and equipment required by it.

(b) All interest at 4% per annum which will accrue on withdrawals shall on the final withdrawal be capitalised.

(c) The sum borrowed plus the capitalised interest shall be repayable by the Board in twenty-seven (27) equal annual instalments (comprising capital and interest), the first instalment to become payable on the 1st January, 1956, and all subsequent instalments on the same date in the years following.
