No. 254. THE ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSIONS LAW. (Law 7 of 1958.)

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 11.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 11 of the Assemblies and Processions Law, 1958, His Excellency the Governor has 7 of 1958 been pleased to make the following regulations:-

- I. These Regulations may be cited as the Assemblies and Processions (Forms) Regulations, 1958.
- 2. In these Regulations the Law means the Assemblies and Processions Law, 1958.
- 3. The form of an application to hold an assembly under sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Law shall be that set out in Form A in the Schedule
- 4. The form of an application to hold a procession under sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Law shall be that set out in Form B in the Schedule hereto.
- 5. The form of a permit to hold an assembly under sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Law shall be that set out in Form C in the Schedule hereto.
- 6. The form of a permit to hold a procession under sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Law shall be that set out in Form D in the Schedule hereto.
- 7. The form of a bond for the purposes of sub-section (3) of section 4 of the Law shall be that set out in Form E in the Schedule hereto.
