THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.

CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954, 18 OF 1955 AND 12 OF 1957.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 443 in the *Gazette* of 4th April, 1957, it is hereby notified for general information that, after considering the plans and specifications concerning the streets set out in the Schedule to the aforementioned notice and objections made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve the plans and specifications concerning the streets enumerated under column (1) to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the conditions shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Nicosia and upon all owners affected.

	(ii) where the plans provide for the alteration of the levels of any sections of the street, and the existing foundation of such sections was laid by or at the expense of the present owners or their predecessors in title in accordance with a permit, the cost of any items of work which, but for the lowering or raising of the level of the street, would not be required for its proper construction, shall be borne by the Town Fund, the amount to be apportioned amongst the owners affected being reduced correspondingly.
